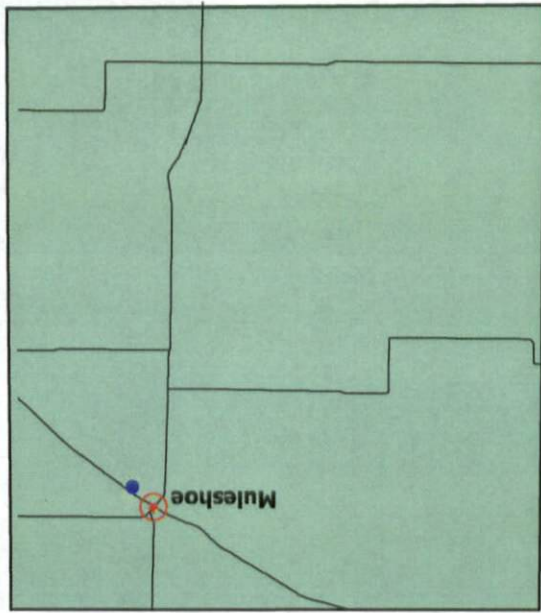

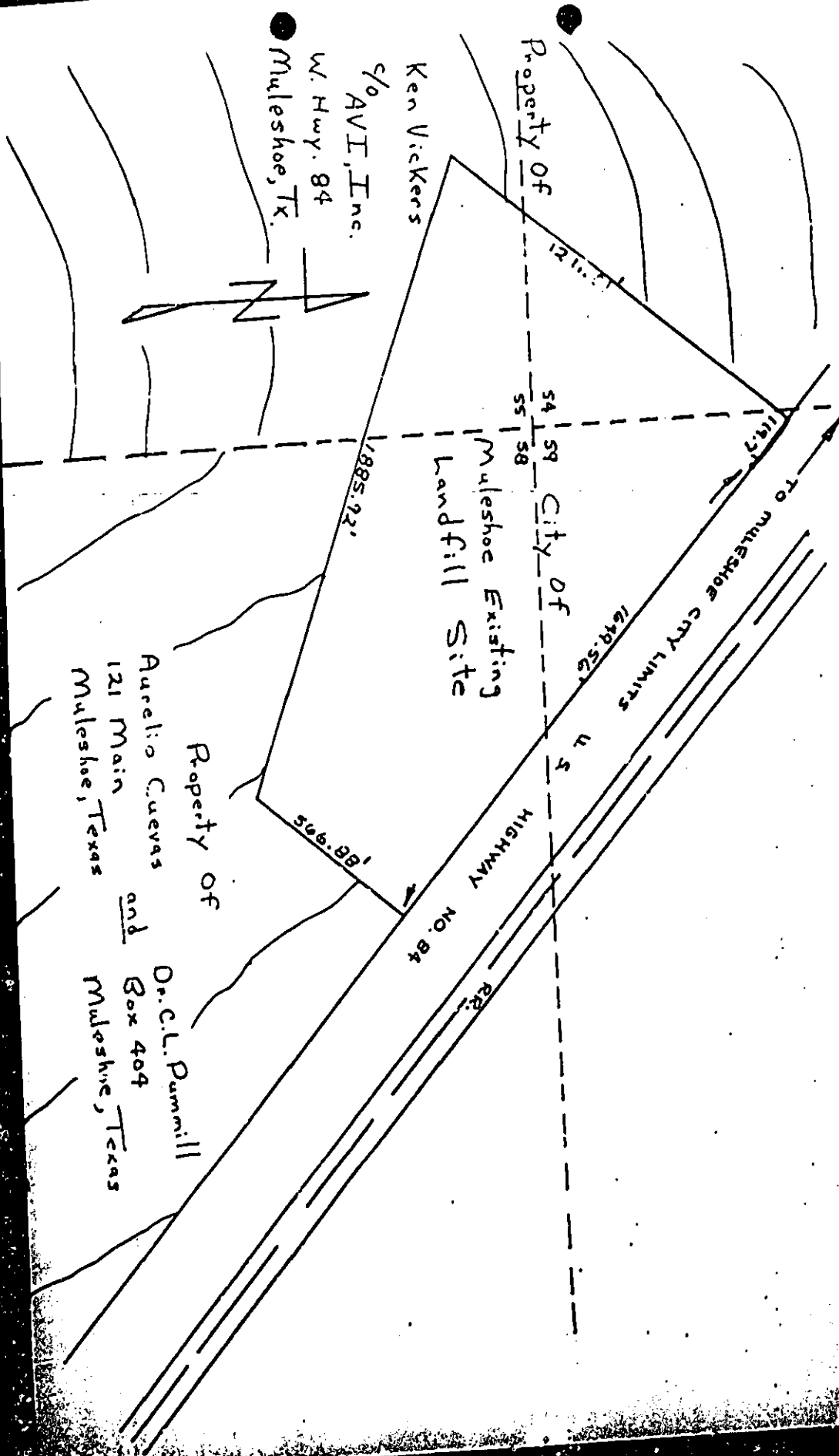

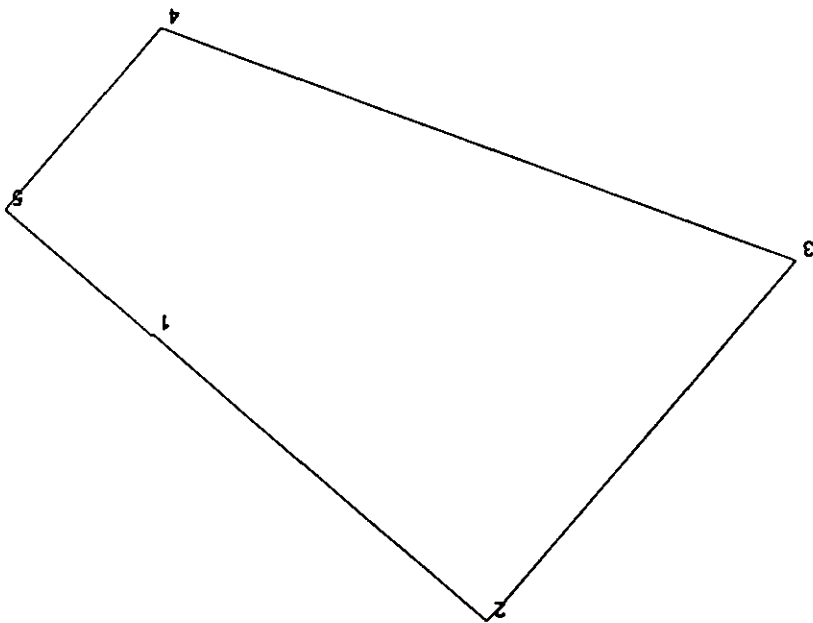

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF TRACT
OF LAND FOR USE BY

AS A SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SITE

STATE OF TEXAS 1
COUNTY OF BAILEY 1

Beginning at a point in the South line of Section 59, a meter-and-bounds description of which is recorded in Vol. 46, page 313, Bailey County Deed Records, where it intersects the South line of U.S. Highway 84 and being 589.1 varas from the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 59;

THENCE N. 49 degrees 12'10" W. along the highway right-of-way, 400 varas to point of curve;

THENCE along curve of said right-of-way to the left, 43.1 varas;

THENCE S 60 degrees 47'50" W. at 33.1 varas cross the West line of Section 59 and the East line of Section 54, and at 379.5 varas cross the North line of Section 55, in all 472.3 varas to the Southwest corner of the tract;

THENCE S 69 degrees 36' E 679 varas to a corner;

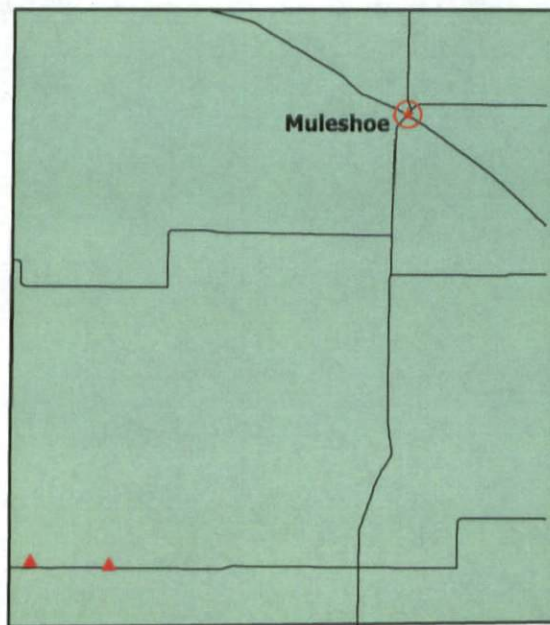
THENCE N 40 degrees 47'50" E 240.1 varas to a corner;

THENCE N 49 degrees 12'10" W along said right-of-way, 193.9 varas to the place of beginning, and containing 35.4 acres of land, more or less.
